R&Rs are always available for review on the Club's website. The Board has asked Club management to ensure our rules and regulations are adhered to. Some of the more commonly overlooked R&R's have been; Members must check in with the Golf Shop prior to their round. Members are required to check their guests in with the golf shop prior to your round. Jackson residents are permitted three (3) total guest rounds per year (Club golf events are excluded from this count). Please adhere to the Club course dress requirements; No denim, Men's golf shirts must be tucked in, Hats must be forward facing everywhere on Club property, Hats are not permitted in the Fireside room, Pay your Club bill when received, the only alcohol allowed to be brought on property is wine in correlation with our wine program. All the Club Rules and Regulations have been reviewed carefully. Adhering to our R&Rs establishes a sense of decorum appropriate for our club.
